Hazardous Household Waste (HHW) Locations

SWACO provides free HHW disposal services for all Franklin County residents. The HHW Center is located at 645 E. 8th Avenue, at the corner of E. 8th and Essex Ave. Its hours are Wednesdays 12 pm–6 pm, Thursdays 9 am-5pm, and Fridays 12 pm-6 pm. They can be reached at 614-294-1300.

There will be HHW Mobile Pickup from 8 am-2 pm on the following dates and locations:

June 23: 4252 Groves Road, Columbus

September 8: 350 Park Meadows Road, Westerville Service Department, Westerville

October 13: 3600 Gantz Road, TOSOH SMD Inc., Grove City

Residents may bring in the following for disposal:

Flammables Lighter fluid, thinners, turpentine, adhesives, gasoline, polishes, kerosene, propane, used oil, oil based paint

Reactives Cyanides, pool chemicals, strong chemicals

Corrosives Acids and caustics, drain cleaners, paint strippers, bleach and household cleaners

Toxics All fluorescent light bulbs, rat poison, insecticides, lawn chemicals and fertilizers, fire extinguishers, antifreeze, household batteries, vehicle batteries, computer batteries, miscellaneous batteries

Note: Latex/water based paint will not be accepted at SWACO HHW collections. Latex paint can be dried out for disposal in the trash. There are paint hardeners available in stores or you can mix the paint with cat litter or sawdust.

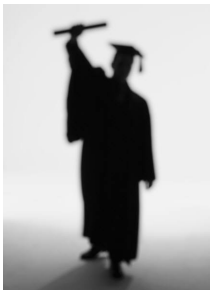

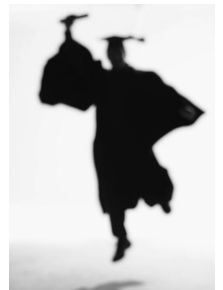
